



# COVERT OPERATION IN LITTLE ITALY

Difficulty level:

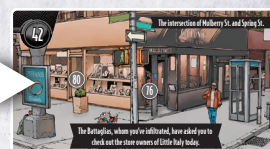
- ▶ You have successfully infiltrated the Battaglia family. Today, Don Salvatore has summoned you to his office. He wants you to check on the stores owned by his organization and ensure that everything is running smoothly. To accomplish this, he has arranged for a car to be waiting just fifty (+50) paces away from the Battaglia Club (17).  $50 + 17 = 17$ . Take card 17.

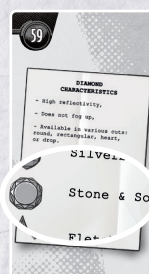
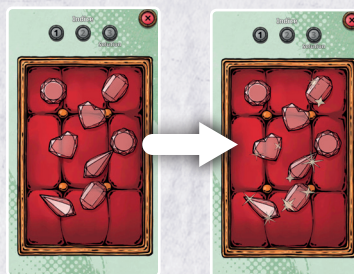
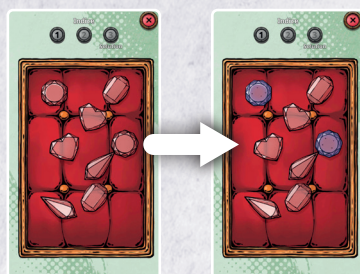


- ▶ Sitting behind the steering wheel, you drive toward the Battaglias' stores. Use the dedicated button to access the Car and select the intersection of Mulberry St. and Spring St. Take card 42.

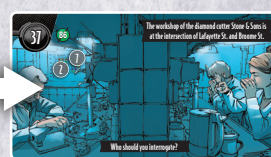


## FAKE DIAMONDS

- ▶ Once you step onto the street, you meet with the store owners and go about your usual routine. However, things take an unexpected turn: the jeweler (80) has received fake stones from one of the Battaglias' diamond cutters and demands that you solve the problem. You examine the diamonds (86) and use the description sheet (59) to distinguish the real ones from the fakes. Blow on your device to fog up the screen, then tilt it from left to right to make the diamonds shine in the light. The diamonds that are fogged up and don't sparkle are the round ones. According to the description sheet, they come from Stone & Sons.



- ▶ As you get into your car (17), you notice a sign indicating that Stone & Sons has a workshop on Lafayette Street. The only diamond cutter on this street is located at the intersection of Lafayette St. and Broom St. Access the Car, then select that intersection. Take card 37.

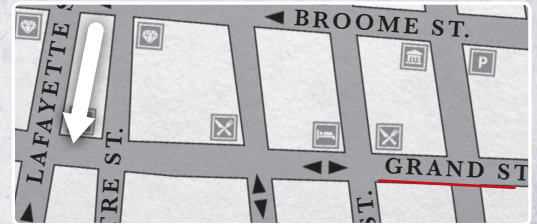




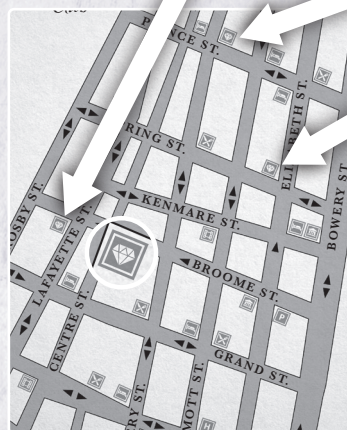
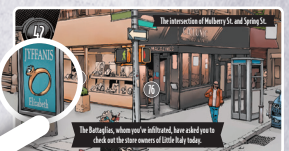
- At Stone & Sons, you find the schedules for the deliverymen (2 and 7). According to the jeweler (80), the deliveryman came by yesterday at noon. Since the newspaper is dated Friday, this means the delivery was made on Thursday at noon deliveryman A, whose delivery route follows a pattern that forms the number 3. Take card 3.



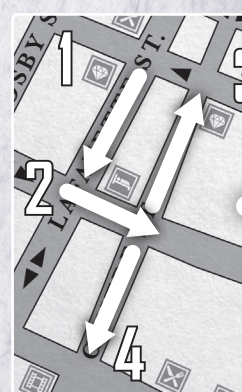
- The deliveryman (3) admits that he exchanges diamonds per Tony's instructions, who supposedly resells on them to someone farther down the street you're currently on and Grand St. If you continue down your current street toward Grand St., you will reach the intersection of Lafayette St. and Grand St. Access the Car, then select that intersection. Take card 7.



- The fence (7) just swa Tony and redirected him to a contact at Fletch Co. While you don't know Fletch Co.'s address, you are aware of the locations of every other diamond cutter in Little Italy, thanks to the posters you've seen (42, 72, and 76). The only diamond cutter on the map for which you lack an address is the one at the intersection of Centre St. and Broom St. Access the car, then select that intersection. Take card 46.



- Upon arriving at Fletch Co., you learn that Tony has just left and gone down the street. Chasing him indefinitely won't help; instead, you need to retrace his steps to figure out where to go next. Therefore, you track his route (37, 77, and 46) from Stone & Sons. He passed through the intersections of Lafayette St. and Broom St., Lafayette St. and Grand St., and then Centre St. and Broom St. before heading back down Centre St. As you trace this path on your map, you outline the shape of the number 4. Take card 4.





- ▶ As you drive through the streets of Little Italy, you don't run into Tony, but into some Triad thugs (4), who bully you. They're not here to chat, and you need to protect your cover. So, you grab your baseball bat (12) and attack them.

$$4 + 12 = 16$$

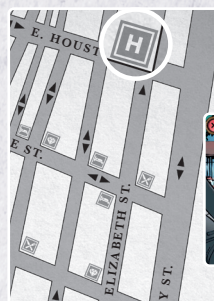
Take card 16.



- ▶ One of the Triad members, whom you've beaten up (16), tells you that he injured Tony and that now Tony is being treated by physicians. There are two hospitals in Little Italy. One is on Mott St., but according to the newspaper, it no longer accepts patients. The other hospital is located at the intersection of E. Houston St. and Elizabeth St. Access the Car, then select that intersection.



**Influenza Outbreak at Mott Street Hospital**  
An influenza outbreak has hit St. Mary's Hospital, affecting numerous patients and staff over the past few days. To prevent the spread of the virus, the hospital has temporarily suspended admissions. As a result, the emergency department had to be relocated to the northern part of the district. Specialist teams have been deployed to disinfect and secure the facility.



Take card 74.

- ▶ When you arrive at the hospital, you find Tony's room guarded by a policewoman (74). Since the beginning of your adventure, you have kept your FBI badge hidden to protect your cover (22). Now you must present your badge (+22) to the policewoman to gain access to Tony and interrogate him.

$$+22 + 74 = 96$$

Take card 96.



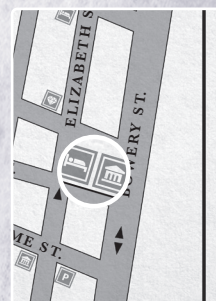
- ▶ Tony is bedridden and seems bitterly remorseful. Vittorio forced him to exchange the diamonds and resell them on his behalf. Vittorio told him that everything would change tonight. You must notify your FBI colleagues of any significant developments involving the Battaglias. Access Machine 34.



- ▶ Your superiors ordered you to find Vittorio before the situation gets out of hand. Their intel indicates that Vittorio recently made a purchase at a luxury hotel. You saw an ad for The Belisario in the newspaper. It is the only luxury hotel, and it is situated next to a museum.

The only hotel that fits that description on the map is located at the intersection of Kenmare St. and Elizabeth St. Access the Car, then select that intersection.

Take card 6.





- ▶ At the bar of the Bellisario, you overhear a customer mentioning that a mobster is staying in a room on her floor (44). That mobster can only be Vittorio. Access the elevator (Machine 55) and go upstairs.

The 4th floor is the only one that matches the customer's description: the room with the golden handle is far from the elevator, and there is another room opposite.

Room 402 is occupied by the customer from the lobby. The room opposite – 403 - is occupied by a bartender. Next to room 402 is a room occupied by a certain Gina. Finally, Luna Ricci has a room near the elevator, which must be room 400 because room 405 is not booked according to the key panel at the front desk (35). Therefore, Vittorio must be in room 404.

Press the door of room 404.

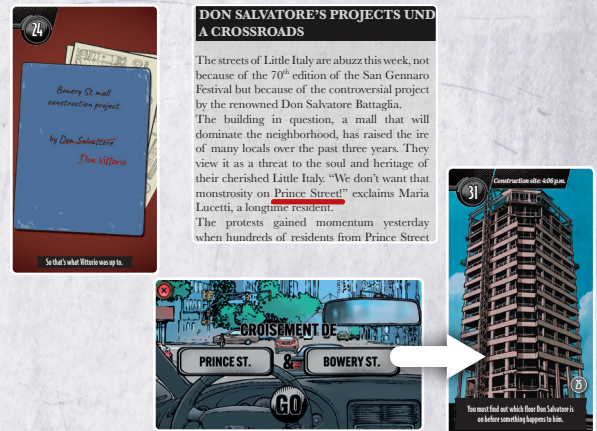
Take card 29.



- ▶ You arrest Vittorio and search his room. Inside, you find a file (24) related to a construction site on Bowery St. Vittorio has crossed out Don Salvatore's name and replaced it with his own. Vittorio truly wants to take his place, so you need to locate him. An article in the newspaper indicates that Don Salvatore is at a construction site on Prince Street, which is the same site as the one in the file.

Access the Car and select the intersection of Prince St. and Bowery St.

Take card 31.



- ▶ According to the newspaper, Don Salvatore will be on the top floor of the building under construction (31). To access this top floor, you must first determine its number. Check card (55) to see whether you should count from 0 or 1. Notably the Ground Floor is designated as 1. Starting from 1, count all the flights in the building; there are a total of 15 flights.

Take card 15.



- ▶ You find Don Salvatore holding a briefcase (15). Thinking over the information you found in Vittorio's room (29), you have reason to believe that Vittorio planted a booby trap in Don Salvatore's briefcase. You decide to open it cautiously with the key (63) you took from the room.

$$15 + 63 = 78$$

Take card 78.

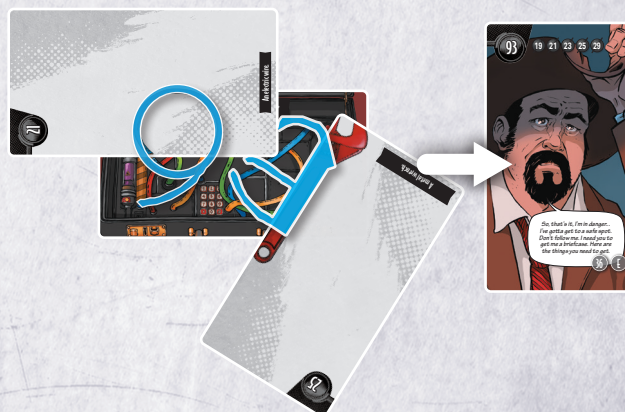




- The briefcase contains a bomb (78). Quickly remove the cover to access the interior and defuse it. Place the flat screwdriver (73) correctly on the notch of the screw holding the bomb cover, and then insert the metal wrench (25) to loosen the damaged nut. This will reveal the number 19. Take card 19.

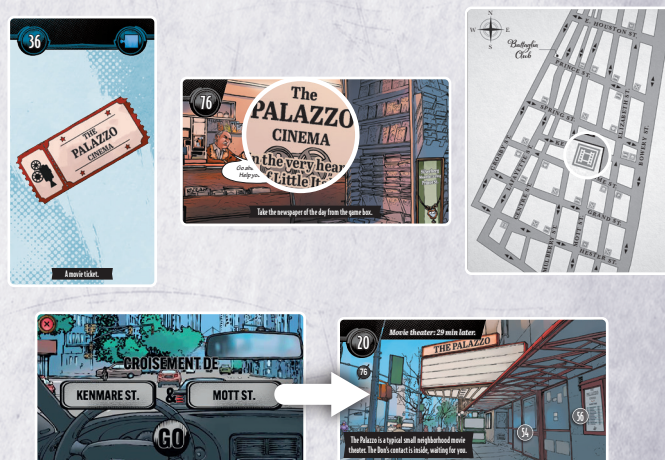


- Once you remove the cover, you see a multitude of wires (19). To stop the timer, create a short circuit by connecting the blue wires with your blue electrical wire (21), to form the number 9. Next, connect the red wires—not with another wire, but with your metal wrench (25), which can conduct electricity—to form the number 3. Take card 93.



## THE DELIVERY

- After being rescued, Don Salvatore goes into hiding and instructs you to attend a meeting. According to the ticket (36) and the accompanying message (1), the meeting is scheduled at The Palazzo Cinema. You saw a poster for this movie theater (76) while at the newsstand. It is in the heart of Little Italy. The only cinema marked at the center of the map is at the intersection of Kenmare St. and Mott St. Access the car and select that intersection. Take card 20.





► You check the time as soon as you arrive at the movie theater (20). You were at the construction site (31) at 4:06 p.m. and arrived at the cinema 29 minutes later, which means it is now 4:35 p.m. The message (E) indicates that you must enter the auditorium (54) where a movie is rolling the end credits (56). According to the schedule, "Cuore Spezzato" is being screened in Auditorium 4. This movie is 2 hours long and will end in 10 minutes. You enter Auditorium 4 (62) with your ticket (36).

$$36 + -62 = 98$$

Take card 98.

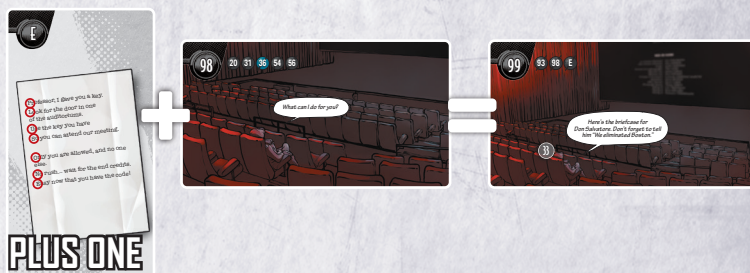


► Someone is waiting for you in the movie theater (98).

The message (E) contains the password you must provide to your contact. To reconstruct that password, read only the capital letters: "PLUS ONE."

$$98 + 1 = 99$$

Take card 99.



► Your contact (99) hands you over a briefcase (33). He also delivers the message: "We eliminated Boston," referring to match scores. The briefcase contains critical information for the FBI. The results of the New York (NYY) winning matches against Boston (BOS) are in the newspaper. The scores were 3-2 and 4-1.

To open the briefcase (33), enter code 3241.

Take card N.



► Inside the briefcase, you find a note addressed to Don Salvatore (N), evidence of a contraband delivery. You contact your FBI colleagues.

Access Machine 34.

Take card 48.



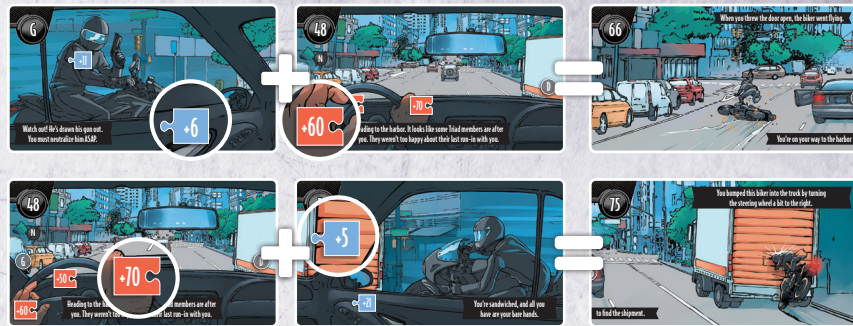


- ▶ You are driving towards Howland Hook Harbor when two Triad bikers (0 and 6) start chasing you. While driving (48), you open the car door (-6) with your left hand (-60) and send one biker fly. You simultaneously turn the steering wheel (-70) towards a truck (-5), pinning the biker on your right. He slams into it.

$$-60 + -6 = 66$$

$$-70 + -5 = 75$$

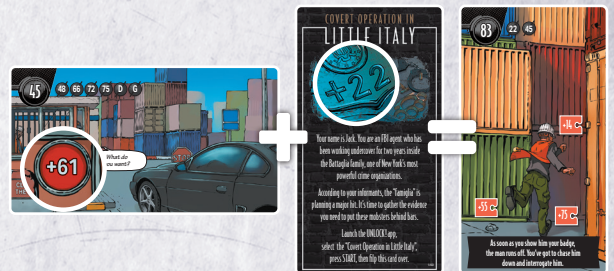
Take cards 66 and 75.



- ▶ After dealing with the bikers, you arrive at the entrance to Howland Hook Harbor and present your FBI badge (+22) to the security guard (+61).

$$+61 + +22 = 83$$

Take card 83.



- ▶ When you show your badge, the man immediately runs away, but you have a few questions for him. You throw your baseball bat (12) at his legs (-75) to stop him in his flight, causing him to trip and fall.

$$12 + -75 = 87$$

Take card 87.



- ▶ The fugitive (87) taunts you, saying that the container you are looking for "is hidden deep inside a warehouse," and that it is "boxed away from the light," giving you another clue to find it.

Lift the box insert to find the container.



- ▶ You found the warehouse with the open container overflowing with contraband weapons!

You access the payphone (34) to alert your colleagues, but the line has no dial tone. You call the secure line, which changes daily. Another daily change is in the newspaper, more precisely in the classifieds. In today's edition, you noticed an ad about a group of unusual neighbors in Little Italy. The ad contains a phone number and the capital letters F, B, and I, which are placed inappropriately, indicating that this ad is meant for you.

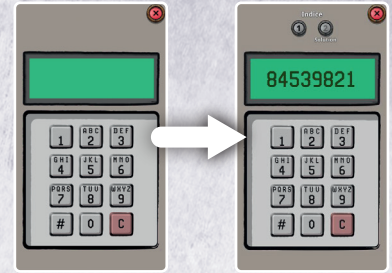
Therefore, you call number 5553855.

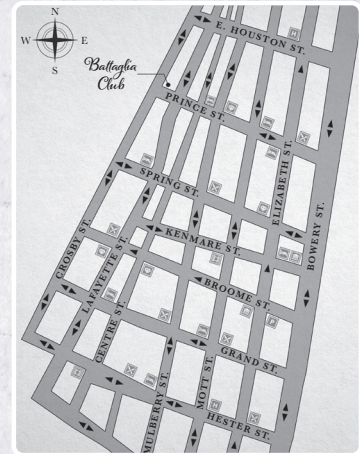




- You successfully contact your colleagues, who request the container number. Type each digit of the container number on the keyboard, replacing the letters A and D with their corresponding numbers. You type 84539821.



- You are pursuing Don Salvatore through Little Italy. Use the map and the information you get over the radio to chase him while avoiding accidents. Take the shortest route to catch him fast.
